

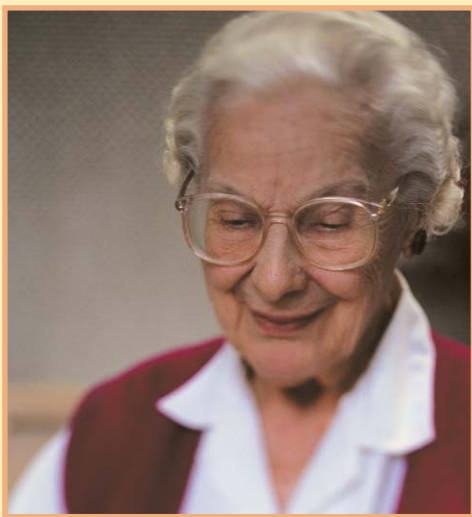

Harleston House is owned and operated by Greensleeves Homes Trust, which is a “not-for-profit” charitable organisation providing care and accommodation for elderly people. Our aim is to offer you high quality care, in a safe and friendly environment, which respects your rights, dignity and privacy, and gives you the maximum opportunity to exercise personal autonomy and choice.

All our homes are registered with the appropriate statutory authority and comply with the relevant legislation. They are also visited every month by a member of Greensleeves’ senior management team, to monitor their compliance with our own quality standards.





Harleston House is a large and beautiful house, which was built in Lowestoft at the beginning of the 19th Century. It is a listed building and has been the

home of many of the town's most prominent people, including its first Mayor. It has been used as a school and, during the Second World War, was used by the Admiralty as a hospital and as a billet for the Wrens.

Accommodation



There is accommodation for twenty-four elderly residents, all in single rooms. Each individual room is fully carpeted and furnished and equipped with a call bell system, T.V. point, easily accessible light switches and plug sockets. All have a wash hand-basin with a mirror, shaving light and shaving socket. Residents are encouraged to bring in personal items such as pictures, ornaments and small items of furniture.

A pay phone is available for residents' use, but if you wish, you may have a telephone in your own room. You will have to take responsibility yourself for the cost of the installation, line rental and quarterly bills.



Dining



Our catering team offers residents a choice of menu for each meal, which is usually taken in the Dining Room. Medical and special diets can also be catered for.



Facilities



There are three lovely sitting rooms, two of which are set aside for those who wish to watch

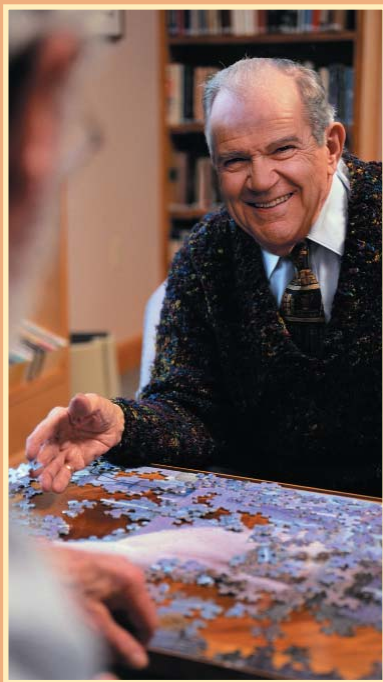


television, and a spacious and comfortable dining room.

The home has a large garden with a summerhouse to which residents have access.

There is a lift to all floors, full central heating and an emergency call system throughout the house.

Activities



Each resident is encouraged to lead his/her own life as independently as possible, and individual cultural and religious needs are respected. There is a full programme of social activities for those who wish to take part.

Staffing



A qualified and experienced senior staff team provide 24 hour management cover for the home, and they are ably supported by trained Care Assistants, catering and domestic staff.
